## SSC CGL Tier III Exam Syllabus

**SSC CGL Tier 3 exam syllabus** is a subjective paper that will be taken offline through pen-paper mode.

According to the tier 3rd exam syllabus, the exam is to assess the candidates'

- language proficiency,
- grammar knowledge,
- vocabulary usage
- writing skills in English/Hindi.

In this exam, Candidates are required to write the **essay, summary, application form**, etc. The duration of the Tier III exam is **60 minutes**.

## SSC CGL Syllabus Tier IV

The SSC CGL Tier 4 Exam comprises skill tests that are required for certain government posts. Candidates who secure at least the minimum qualifying marks in the examination (Tier I, II, III) can appear in the Skill Test.

### Data Entry Speed Test:

- should have **8,000 (eight thousand)** Key Depression per hour on the Computer.
- A passage of about **2000 (two thousand)** key depressions for **15 (fifteen)** minutes.

### Computer Proficiency Test:

- Word Processing
- Spreadsheet
